

# Care Card™

## Flute

### DAILY

1. Hold Flute correctly while putting it together so that you will avoid damage to your instrument (As instructed in the Take Care! Take Pride! DVD).
2. Gently remove finger prints from the keys and the body with a soft cloth.
3. When polishing the body, always use lengthwise strokes.
4. Remove water from the inside of the instrument with cleaning rod and appropriate cloth attached to it. Make sure that no part of the metal cleaning rod is exposed to the instrument.
5. Do not use any liquid or paste silver polish on your flute. It will damage the pads and the key bearings.

### WEEKLY

1. Clean all tenons and sockets by rolling dirt off with your fingers. Do not use a cloth to clean tenons, the grease from your fingers is needed for lubrication.

### YEARLY

1. Bring your instrument to a qualified repair technician for a professional regulation and lubrication.

### SUPPLIES NEEDED

Soft Cloth, Cleaning rod, Cleaning Rod Cloth.
